What time commitment do I need to make to the Board?

- (a) Required
 - 3/4 Orientation session
 - 3/4 Approximatelyfour (4) regular Board meetings per yearne day per meeting)
 - 3/4 FallBoard Development Sessicone day).
 - 34 Membership on one Board standing committeeapproximatelyfour (4) meetings per year (½ day per meeting).
 - 3/4 Preparation time for committee and Board meetings
 - 3/4 Attendance at a convocation and other events if requested to represent the Board



(b) Encouraged:

- 3/4 Voluntary attendance at as many College functions as possible (NOTE When attending events on valuntary basis, per diems are national policiable)
- 3/4 Participation in ad hoc committeets required.
