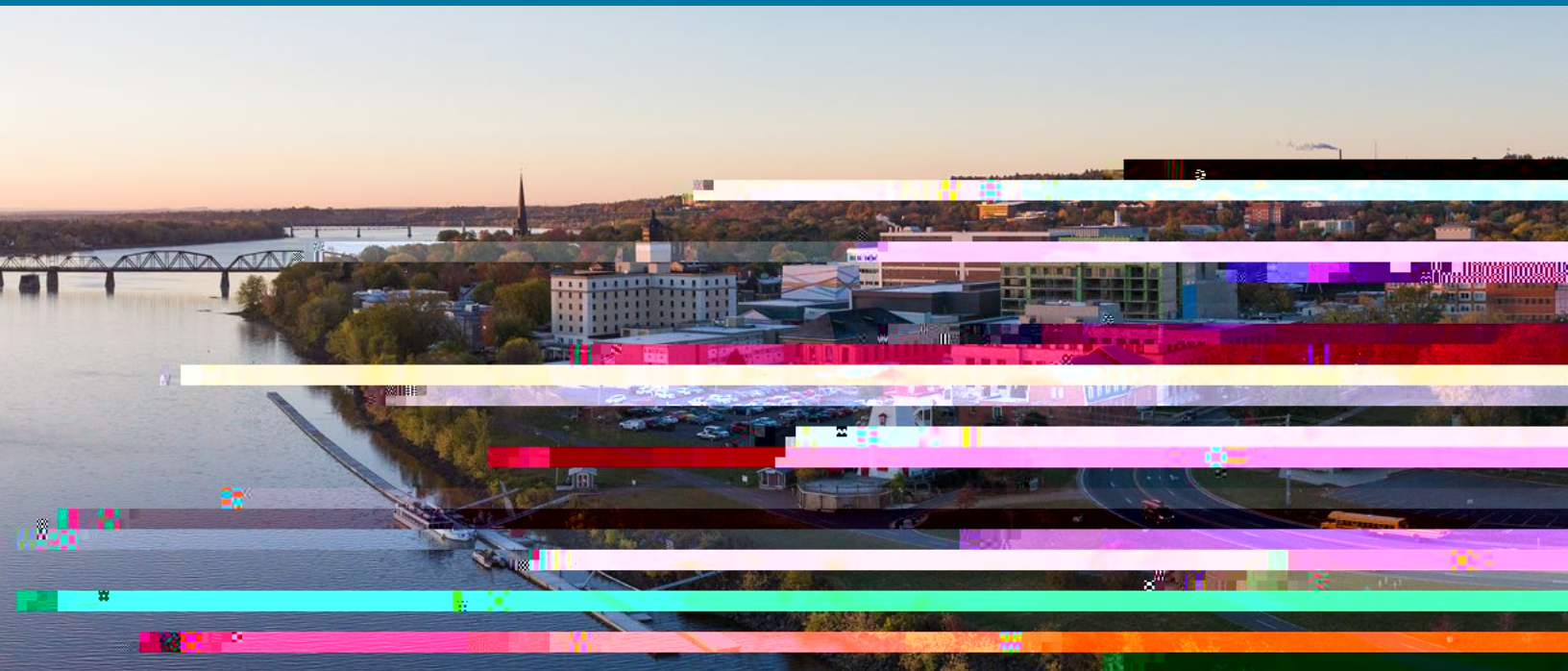

WHAT TO PACK:

- Required documents to present when entering Canada
- Books
- Items that remind you of your home country (eg. *fag, music or family recipes*)
- Medications
- Toiletries
- Weather appropriate clothes
- Light bed linens (*bed sheets, pillowcases, etc*)
- Laptop
- Thermometer

There's no dress code at NBCC. Students here usually dress casually in comfortable and practical clothes. Bring whatever clothing you like, in the style that you are used to wearing. If you're in a co-op program, you'll need additional business attire for interviews and work terms.
